

Program Distribution


Breakdown of ACO tracks for the 476 PY2025 Participants



RISK LEVEL

PY2024 vs. PY2025

NHN is at risk through PY2028. In PY2024, our maximum shared savings was \$89.1M and our maximum shared loss was \$66.8M. Our PY2025 target financials will be provided in May 2025.

ATTRIBUTION

PY2024 vs. PY2025

NHN chose prospective attribution methodology for PY2024 and PY2025.

PROSPECTIVE ATTRIBUTION

Beneficiaries are assigned at the start of the contract PY based on claims in the prior calendar year

RETROSPECTIVE ATTRIBUTION

Retrospective attribution uses the entire performance year's claims data to determine which patients are attributed to the ACO
